Applications are invited from eligible candidates possessing domicile of District Jamshoro to fill the following vacant posts in the District & Sessions Court, Jamshoro.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING:

- As per the instructions of the Hon'ble High Court of Sindh, MCQs-based written test for the posts of Sr. No.01 & 02 shall be conducted through SIBA Testing Services. Interested candidates must submit their applications online through the STS Portal: <http://www.apply.sts.net.pk> on or before 13-05-2026. Manual applications shall not be accepted.
- Candidates must upload their CNIC (front and back), domicile, PRC/Form-D, a recent photograph, NOC (in case of Government Servant) and all academic documents from the respective board. Additionally, any required certifications must also be uploaded to the portal when applying online.
- Candidates with disabilities are required to upload CNIC bearing the wheelchair logo issued by NADRA.
- After completing the online application, candidates can download a system-generated challan of Rs.1,500/- (Rupees Fifteen hundred only). The challan can be paid at any Allied Bank Limited (ABL) branch or via the MyABL app. Alternatively, candidates may use the IBill reference number to pay through the Internet banking portal of any IBill-linked bank. (This fee is non-refundable).
- Candidates must apply and pay the challan separately for each position if applying for more than one.
- The Disability Quota shall be observed in accordance with applicable rules, for the post at Serial No.01 & 02.
- Female candidates shall be provided equal opportunity to participate, for the post at Serial No.01 & 02.
- Candidates are advised to use only their original mobile number in the online application form and refrain from providing numbers that have been converted to another network.
- The date, time and venue shall be intimated later through an SMS alert. Further, all updates and notification about the test dates, admit slips, result announcement or any other information shall be uploaded on the STS website/portal as well. In this regard, candidates must visit the portal/website from time to time.
- In case of any objection during the scrutiny process, candidates shall be notified via SMS and are advised to regularly check both their SMS messages and their accounts on the portal. A period of three (03) days shall be granted to respond to the objection. Failure to comply within the stipulated time shall result in the rejection of the application form.
- No queries shall be entertained after the issuance of admit slips for the MCQs-based written test for posts Serial No. 01 and 02.
- For the post of Driver (BPS-07) mentioned at Sr. No.03, candidates are required to send their applications along-with attested copies of driving license, educational documents, CNIC, Domicile & PRC, 02 passport size photographs by post or by hand addressed to the "District & Sessions Judge, Jamshoro" on or before 13-05-2026 till 03:00 p.m.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION FOR ALL POSTS:

- Incomplete applications and documents shall not be entertained after the closing date.
- Providing fictitious, exaggerated, or misleading information shall result in the rejection of the application and may lead to termination of employment at any stage.
- Candidates already serving in the Government who meet the eligibility criteria may also apply through the proper channel.
- In case of overage candidates, if qualified and selected for appointment on the basis of experience, qualification and skills, their cases shall be submitted to the Worthy Chief Justice, Hon'ble High Court of Sindh, Karachi, for relaxation in the upper age limit and approval.
- Only shortlisted candidates will be called for test/interview.
